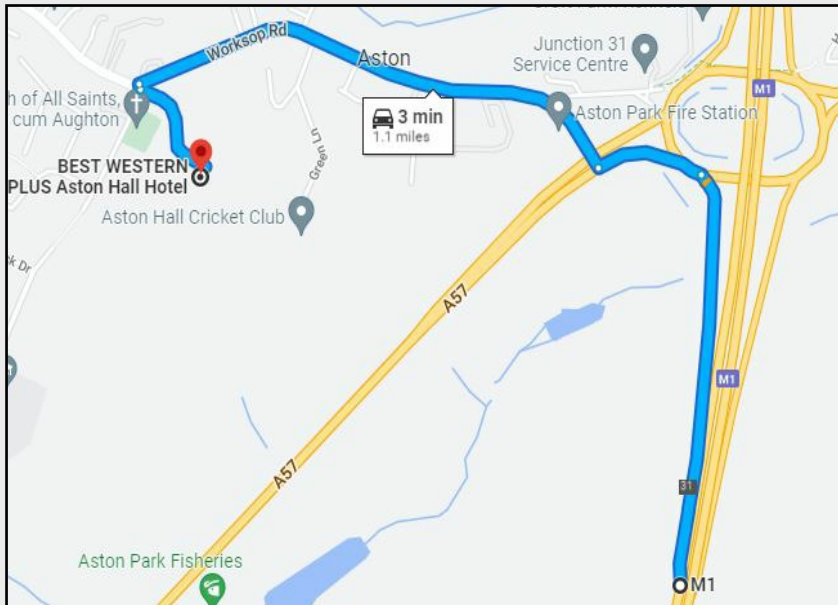

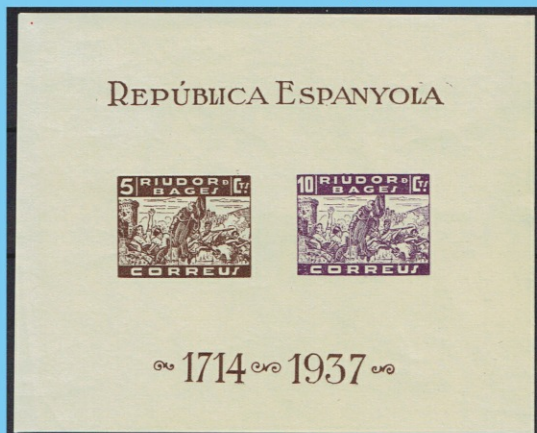

POSTAL HISTORY - ZEPPELIN MAIL
